## **Snow Plowing and Ice Control**

Snow plowing operations will start and take place after a major snow event or blizzard, (five inches or more). Major collector routes, emergency services routes and the area around the school will have priority. Other streets and areas as needed.

### **PRIORITY ROUTES**

- \*Airport Road south from 6<sup>th</sup> Ave. to Adams Ave. (US 12), plowed to the right or west side of street.
- \*Adams Ave. (US 12) from Airport Road east to 10<sup>th</sup> Street, windrowed for blower pickup.
- \*Second(2<sup>nd</sup>) Street South to Railroad Ave. east to 4<sup>th</sup> Street, plowed and piled to the right or south.
- \*Third(3<sup>rd</sup>) Ave. from 4<sup>th</sup> Street South (Firehall) east to 8<sup>th</sup> Street, 8<sup>th</sup> Street north from 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave. South to 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave. South, 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave. South from 8<sup>th</sup> Street west to 4<sup>th</sup> Street, windrowed for blower pickup.
- \*Sixth(6<sup>th</sup>) Street North from Adams Ave. (US 12) to 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave. (between courthouse and library), windrowed for blower pickup.
- \*Main Street from 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave. North south to Railroad Ave., windrowed for blower pickup.
- \*Sixth (6<sup>th</sup>) Ave. North from Airport Road to 8<sup>th</sup> Street North to 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave. North west to Airport Road, Driving Lanes.
- \*Fourth (4<sup>th</sup>) Street from 6<sup>th</sup> Ave. North to Western Horizons, Driving Lanes.
- \*Railroad Ave. from Main Street east to Cemetery Road plowed and piled south or right of street.
- \*Cemetery Road from Railroad Ave. north to Adams Ave. (US 12), plowed and pile east or Right of street.
- \*Thirteenth (13<sup>th</sup>) Street from Adams Ave. (US 12) south to 5<sup>th</sup> Ave. South, Driving Lanes.
- \*Tenth (10<sup>th</sup>) Street from Railroad Ave. north to 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave. North, Driving Lanes.
- \*Mirror Lake Road, Driving Lanes.
- \*Ninth (9<sup>th</sup>) Ave. North, Driving Lanes.
- \*Eleventh (11<sup>th</sup>) Ave. North, Driving Lanes.

**No one should have to drive more than two blocks to a plowed street.**

### **SANDING**

\*Sanding of the streets will take place as needed.

### **SNOW REMOVAL**

\*Snow windrows will be removed from the school areas as soon as possible.

\*Remaining snow windrows will be removed as schedules permit.

\*This **DOES NOT** allow for snow from **ANY** area beyond the curb of the street to be piled onto the street for removal by crews. This includes private driveways, private sidewalks and parking lots. Put the snow on the lawn. **\*ONLY EXCEPTION IS, Downtown businesses may put sidewalk snow in the middle of the street. Provided that it is done so before the snow windrow is picked up. NOT AFTER!!!**

### **SAFETY**

\*Not only for our safety but more so for yours and public safety, avoid operational areas of snow removal equipment, snow blowers, wheel-loaders and snow hauling trucks. We as the crew respectfully ask that all "Site seer's" avoid operational areas to allow maintenance crews to finish clean-up operations.

\*Snow removal crews ask that all boats, campers, motorhomes, trailers or any other vehicles not in use during the winter months (October 15 to April 15) be removed from the street.

\*Snow plowing and removal operations will predominately take place in the early morning hours(2am -7am). **\*NOT DURING THE STORM OR BLIZZARD.**
