**POLICY FOR THE APPROVAL OF APPROACH PERMITS FOR PLACEMENT ON ADAMS COUNTY  
ROADS**

The Adams County Commission has the authority under N.D.C.C. 24-05 to develop and implement rules governing the placement of approaches. Therefore the county commission has developed the following rules for approval of the placement of approaches:

BEFORE PERMISSION CAN BE GRANTED, a permit application must be submitted to the Adams County Commission complying with the following for **NEW**

**APPROACHES:**

1. The county road superintendent must be contacted, prior to submitting the application, for review of the intended location.
2. The approach must be built to conform to county specifications.
3. The requesting party will be responsible for the total cost of the installation and materials.
4. The county road superintendent must be contacted for inspection upon completion.

BEFORE PERMISSION CAN BE GRANTED, a permit application must be submitted to the Adams County Commission complying with the following for **EXISTING APPROACHES:**

1. The county road superintendent must be contacted prior to commencing any improvements to existing approaches.
2. The improvement must be built to conform to county specifications.
3. The county will supply culvert to replace existing culvert if needed. The requesting party will be responsible for total cost of the improvement, including extension(s), if needed.
4. The county road superintendent must be contacted for inspection upon completion.
