

ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE #33, PERMITTING AND CONTROLLING THE USE OF DISH TYPE SATELLITE SIGNAL RECEIVING STATIONS, TRANSFER APPEALS TO THE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS AND TO ATTACH CRIMINAL PENALTIES.

The Township Board of the Township of Argentine ordains:

Section 1. Dish type Satellite Signal Receiving Stations (hereafter "Stations"), subject to the following regulations, may be located within the Township of Argentine, Genesee County, Michigan.

Section 2. Stations shall not be linked to receivers which are not located on the same lot as the Station, unless said property is owned by the same person or persons.

Section 3. Stations shall be located in the "Yard, rear", as defined in the Argentine Township Zoning Code, and behind the principal dwelling or structure located on the lot; shall be located so that however turned or otherwise used, all parts of the Station will be set back at least five (5) feet from the inner side yard lines; and shall be set back from the rear lot line no less than twenty (20) feet or one-half the depth of the rear yard, whichever is greater.

Section 4. The height of the Station, should the dish antenna be turned perpendicular to the ground, shall not extend above fifteen (15) feet; and the maximum diameter of any dish antenna shall not exceed twelve (12) feet.

Section 5. No installation or erection of a Station shall commence before a permit is obtained from the Argentine Township Building Inspector.

Section 6. The Board of Zoning Appeals of the Township of Argentine is hereby empowered to grant variances to this ordinance wherein, in its discretion, a literal enforcement of this ordinance will work an unreasonable hardship on persons, firms or corporations affected hereby.

Section 7. Any person, actual or corporate, who violates the provisions of this ordinance or who urges or aids any other person, actual or corporate to violate this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be sentenced to a fine of up to \$500.00 and/or ninety (90) days imprisonment.
