Bell County Severe Weather Update - 05/23/24 11:15 a.m.

Belton, TX – In an effort to better understand the scope of the issue, Bell County Emergency Management is requesting that residents in the unincorporated portions of the county report any debris that is obstructing public roadways.

As always, if an obstruction represents an emergency, it should be reported first to 9-1-1. Once that is done, residents in the unincorporated portions of the county can call 254-933-5598 to report debris impacting roadways.

Additionally, while the county recognizes the desire of residents to clear debris from their properties, it is critical that debris not be moved into the street. Instead, residents are asked to move debris no closer than the right-of-way to ensure that traffic is not impacted.
