


### 1051\* Total Conditions, 2023



\*Covid numbers not included. 9,788 both probable and confirmed Covid cases were reported. Not included home tests


U.S. Census Bureau Population Estimates for Bell County, TX, 7/1/2023: 388,386.

#### **Outbreaks** and Concerns

#### Zoonosis - Malaria

#### 39F, Temple

Born in Nigeria, moved to US 6 years ago. Bitten repeatedly by mosquitos 12/22/23 – 1/13/24 at Port Harcourt, Nigeria. No chemoprophylaxis

Chills, fever, bodyache, headache, sepsis

20yrs ago was treated for Malaria

#### **Measles Notification**

Between 12/1/2023 and 1/23/2024 CDC has 23 confirmed US measles cases. 7 were directly imported from international travelers. 2 outbreaks involved 5+ cases

Most cases were among unvaccinated children and adolescents
