Bike paths or natural areas would be great. No pools or playgrounds needed. Enough of those available.

I have been extremely disappointed with having no pool in Berlin Township. We cannot use the Orange Township pool and the YMCA pool in Delaware was closed to non-residents during the pandemic. We need a community pool immediately.

Muti-use trails are an essential safety issue in our township. Trails assist in keeping residents out of streets, avoiding traffic, and enhance/protect our natural environment.

I would love to see a natural play area at a park, like the one at Shale Hollow. Wouldn't have to be a big area. Stick forts and rocks also don't cost as much as playground equipment!

I believe that with Alum Creek State Park being as lose to Berlin Twp. as it is, it provides more than enough options to the residents of Berlin Twp. I see no reason to provide additional amenities until the ones that are available no longer handle the volume of people using them.

Trails to safely navigate to the surrounding community trail from our subdivision.

We have a state park in our neighborhood. Current and future projects should include or already do include these amenities. Our tax dollars should be used to upgrade current services.

50 meter convertible to 25 yards swimming pool. The four Olentangy District HS teams have to rent time in other facilities around the county. It would be great for someone to provide a centralized place for them to swim and gain revenue from pool time fees. 50 meters also allow for USA Swimming club swimmers to practice in an Olympic size pool better preparing them for Olympic trials cuts. Also, there are many club swimmers in Berlin Township and they have to travel to Columbus, New Albany, or Westerville to swim club. A pool would also allow a USA Swimming club/clubs to rent time and provide competitive swimming opportunities closer to home.

Berlin is long overdue for a pool and community center with more and more homes going in every day. We've had to pay for memberships at surrounding pools and need something in our area for Berlin residents. After 13 years of living here and always having to travel to other neighboring communities (which are already crowded) for options it's quite apparent Berlin is severely lacking in these areas.

Please connect our township with bike trails.

We need all of these things. Parks, pools, trails, communities centers are what makes any community great. These things will bring happiness to the community.

Start with a pool for resident buy in.

There needs to be a paved path to Alum Creek Marina. Hollenback gets very busy and dangerous for people to walk or bike to the Marina currently.

"Would really appreciate sidewalks in the Old State/ Hollenback area leading both to the elementary school as well as to the Marina. As a resident of the Marina neighborhood, we'd like to be able to walk to the Marina and dog park and ride bikes to the school, but it feels very dangerous walking alongside Hollenback. People spead constantly down Hollenback - especially around the curve leading to the Marina.

A splash pad and township park with a playground would be AMAZING!

Green space matters... please continue to take into consideration as housing continues to explode here. The green space was a BIG reason we chose Berlin township!

Build a bike path on Africa road before someone gets seriously hurt biking there.

We already have enough parks.

At this time inflation is a serious problem. The taxes here are out of control. They are hight than the East Coast rates. Costs are too high for basic living expenses. We cannot bare any more expenses. You are hurting residents. You have enough coming in from tax revenue now. Use it smarter. Charge users for services, not residents that don't choose to use those services by increasing their taxes. This is an area with significant outdoor recreation opportunities. That is enough. We will fight this if it goes further.

Spray off hoses/areas at Alum Creek Beach at the base of the paths leading back to the parking lots where the trash cans are (like they have at the public ocean beaches). The ones at the main shelter house are out of the way if you are at the farther ends of the beach and parking lots. Thanks for your consideration.

As a Berlin Township resident for over 28 years, I am very interested in having walking/biking trails along S Old State to 36/37, over the Cheshire causeway and along Africa Road.
