Homeowners must have and explain a financial hardship directly related to COVID-19 on or after January 21, 2020.

Apply for Up to \$25,000 Grant Per Household to Pay:

- Delinquent mortgage/housing expenses, including property tax and insurance escrow shortages
- Delinquent land contract payments, mobile home consumer loan payments or mobile home park lot payments
- Delinquent property taxes
- Delinquent condominium/homeowner's association fees
- Delinquent homeowner's insurance
- Delinquent utilities, gas, electric, water, sewer
- Delinquent internet broadband services

#### BRUSH PICK-UP

DPW will begin brush pick-up on April 18th.

This service is provided to Township residents only. We will not provide service for work done by commercial tree trimmers.

- Brush should be put out by 7am on a Monday morning to ensure weekly pick up.
- Brush should be laid out near the edge of the street with the cut ends towards the road.
- No piece of brush should be larger in diameter than 6 inches or longer than 6 feet.
- Logs should be separated from brush.

The various committees established by Buena Vista Charter Township play a vital role in balancing the social service needs of the Township. Serving on a Township committee is a great way to become involved and engaged in important governmental matters, serve as stewards of Township's tax dollars, and contribute to the growth of our beloved community.
