Sherriff Wrigglesworth – 23 new deputies have been hired to replace the officers who have retired since 2018. Sheriff's Department had to work hard to fill positions as people are not going into law enforcement. Hiring a lot of military veterans.

Break ground in May of this year on the justice complex. Old animal control has been torn down. Will take approximately 30 months to build.

Investing mileage money into mental illness and addictions with inmates in hope they do not turn back to crime.

Sheriff's department polices the fair. Possibility of alcohol in grandstands. Fair could be different next year.

Strongly working on rebuilding relationships with out county. Have a strong relationship with State Police.

Ulrey – What can the Township do to help the police do their job. Wrigglesworth - Talk to commissioners to remind them they need budget to put officers on the road.

Relationship with ICE – Hold them for 48 hours after release. Wrigglesworth contacts ICE to inform them when they are getting released up to 3 times.

Marijuana – Where is marijuana headed?

Sherriff – No dispensaries in rural Ingham county. One is going in in Webberville. Since became legal it has not become an issue. No roadside tests for drivers for Marijuana.
