

ORDINANCE NO. 236

AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING SOLICITORS, PEDDLERS, HAWKERS, ITINERANT MERCHANTS, TRANSIENT VENDORS OF MERCHANDISE, AND TRANSIENT PHOTOGRAPH SOLICITORS; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 180.

The Town of Canyon City ordains as follows:

Section 1. Uninvited Solicitation Prohibited. The practice of persons of going in and upon private property or calling at residences in the town of Canyon City, Oregon, by solicitors, peddlers, hawkers, itinerant merchants, transient vendors of merchandise, and transient photograph solicitors, not having been requested or invited so to do by the owner or owners, occupant or occupants of said private residences, for the purpose of soliciting orders for the sale of goods, wares, and merchandise or for the purpose of disposing of or peddling or hawking the same, or soliciting orders for photographs, is hereby prohibited and declared to be a nuisance.

Section 2. Enforcement. It shall be the duty of the police officers employed by the city to enforce this ordinance.

Section 3. Penalty. Any person, firm, or corporation violating this ordinance shall be subject to a fine not more than \$500.

Section 4. Repeal. Ordinance No. 180, enacted February 7, 1979, is repealed.

Passed by the council and approved by the mayor October 22, 1986.
