Public Hearings:

1. Garbage/Recycling Collection Operating/Maintenance Special Assessment District:

For fiscal year 2018-2019, the budgeted amount needed for expenditures and other uses is \$362,240 which requires a 2018 tax levy of \$150.00 per housing unit. This is the same levy as 2017.

Public Comments: None.

2. Fire Operating/Maintenance Special Assessment District:

For fiscal year 2018-2019, the budgeted amount needed for expenditures and other uses is \$224,332 which requires a millage levy of 2.75 mills on the taxable value for real property. This is 0.75 more than the 2017 levy.

Public Comments: None.

3. Police Operating/Maintenance Special Assessment District:

For fiscal year 2018-2019, the budgeted amount needed for expenditures and other uses is \$743,980 which requires a millage levy of 9.2 mills on the taxable value for real property. This is the same levy as 2017.

Public Comments:

Rose King, 3427 N. Michigan, stated that the crossing guards need new stop signs as they are falling apart and do not blink as they should.
