Resolution Authorizing Chief Elected Official To Sign An Application For Nebraska Affordable Housing Program Funds

Whereas, the City of Central City, Nebraska, is an eligible unit of a general local government authorized to file an application under the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 as Amended for Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Program, and, Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act of 1990 (HOME Program) funds distributed by the Department of Economic Development through the Nebraska Affordable Housing Program.

Whereas, the City of Central City, Nebraska, has obtained its citizens' comments on community development and housing needs; and has conducted public hearing(s) upon the proposed application and received favorable public comment respecting the application which for an amount of \$193,513 for Rehabilitation of six (6) owner-occupied single family units within the municipal boundaries of the City of the City of Central City, Nebraska; for a minimum total of six (6) units rehabilitated for the proposed project; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Central City, that the Central City Mayor be authorized and directed to proceed with the formulation of any and all contracts, documents or other memoranda between the City of Central City and the Nebraska Department of Economic Development so as to effect acceptance of the grant application.
