Presentation of Resolution to Waiver Annexation in exchange for a twenty-foot (20) sewer easement across Parcel Numbers 0030B 018 AND 00308 019, as identified by the Murray County Tax Assessor's Office, and also identified as 190 West pine Street. The City of Chatsworth does hereby waive all annexation requirements for the connection to the public sewer system, to be owned and operated by the Chatsworth Water Works Commission, for the current owner Mitchell Leonard and future owners of said property.
