The Chatsworth City Council met on Monday, August 3, 2020, at 6:00 p.m. in the council chambers of CityHall with Mayor K. W. Gong presiding.

PRESENT: Mayor K. W. Gong, Aldermen: Rhett Griffin, Terry Crump, Jeff Cloer and Fred Welch. City Attorney Steve Williams and City Clerk Wilma Nolan.

Mayor Gong called the meeting to order and presented the minutes of the last meeting and the agenda for the current meeting.

Fred, "I make a motion we accept the minutes and also make a motion to add the resolution for the cares act to the agenda for tonight."

Rhett seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 4 to 0.

Request by the Chatsworth Housing authority to appoint Rhett Griffin as vice-chairman of the Housing Authority -

Request for a malt beverage and distilled spirits license for Gustavo Villarreal Cabrera, La Fiesta Mexicana Restaurant, 1422 Green Road, Chatsworth -

Rhett, "I make a motion we approve it." Jeff seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 4 to 0.

Request the approval of a resolution allowing a referendum to permit and regulate Sunday sales of package malt beverage and wine - The resolution reads as follows:

RESOLUTION CONCERNING SUNDAY PACKAGE SALES

The Mayor and Council for the City of Chatsworth having received strong interest in Sunday package sales of beer and wine: and

The Mayor and Council for the City of Chatsworth having determined that Sunday package sales will have a positive economic impact; and

The Mayor and Council for the City of Chatsworth having determined that there would be very little other impact from Sunday package sales,

BE IT RESOLVED:

The Mayor and Council for the City of Chatsworth, being the governing authority thereof, hereby determines that the election superintendent for Murray County shall issue the call and conduct an election on November 3, 2020, for the purpose of submitting the question of Sunday

package sales by retailers of both malt beverages and wine to the voters of the City of Chatsworth for approval or rejection. The ballot shall have written thereon the words;

- "() YES Shall the governing authority of City of Chatsworth be authorized to permit and regulate package sales by retailers of both malt beverages and wine on Sundays between the hours of 12:30 P.M. and 11:30 P.M.?"
- () NO

All persons that are desiring to vote for approval of package sales by retailers of malt beverages and wine on Sundays between the hours of 12:30 P.M. and 11:30 P.M. shall vote "yes" and all persons desiring to vote for rejection of package sales by retailers of malt beverages and wine on Sundays between the hours of 12:30 P.M. and 11:30 P.M. shall vote "no". If more than 1/2 of the votes cast on the question are for approval of Sunday package sales by retailers of malt beverages and wine on Sundays between the hours of 12:30 P.M. and 11:30 P.M., the resolution approving such Sunday package sales by retailers of both malt beverage and wine shall be come effective upon January 1, 2021. The Election superintendent shall canvass the returns, declare the result of the election, and certify the result to the Secretary of State.

Mayor Gong advised that if this passed, it would be up for vote by the public here at City Hall on November 3, 2020.

Mayor Gong presented the resolution for the city to execute the coronavirus relief fund and accept the grant payments - The resolution reads as follows:

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CHATSWORTH TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF THE CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND (CRF) TERMS AND CONDITIONS AGREEMENT; TO AUTHORIZE THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT PAYMENTS, INCLUDING UNDERSTANDINGS AND ASSURANCES CONTAINED WITHIN SUCH AGREEMENT; TO DIRECT AND AUTHORIZE THE PERSON IDENTIFIED AS THE OFFICIAL REPRESENTATIVE OF THE CITY, OR THE DESIGNEE OF THE CITY TO ACT IN CONNECTION WITH THE GRANT APPLICATION; AND TO PROVIDE SUCH ADDITIONAL INFORMATION AS MAY BE REQUIRED.

WHEREAS, in an effort to mitigate the effects of COVID-19, the United States government has made available grant funding through the Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF) to the State of Georgia, which was established within Section 601 of the Social Security Act, as added by Section 5001 of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Safety Act (CARES Act);

WHEREAS, Governor Brian P. Kemp has authorized the sharing of CRF allocations and disbursements in a phased, measure approach with local governments across the State of Georgia;

WHEREAS, Governor Kemp has acknowledged the critical need that such CRF funding be released to local governments experiencing immediate need as quickly as possible and has directed the Governor's Office of Planning and Budget (OPB) to coordinate with local governments to achieve allocation and disbursement of such CRF funding;

WHEREAS, OPD has created and will administer a grant management system, GeorgiaCARES, which local governments, including the City shall utilize in order to receive allocations and disbursements of CRF funding; and

WHEREAS, OPD and the State of Georgia, require formal, official action of the City governing authority to that the CRF funding may be disbursed to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATSWORTH, GEORGIA:

Section 1. Execution of Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF) Terms and Conditions. The Mayor and Council hereby authorize the execution, delivery, and performance of the Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF) Terms and Conditions (Agreement) in substantially the form attached hereto as a composite Exhibit A and the acceptance of payments, including all understandings and assurances contained herein.

Section 2. Other Actions Authorized. The City hereby directs and authorizes the Mayor of the City of Chatsworth or the designee of the Mayor to act in connection with the Grant application and to provide such additional information as may be required by OPB, federal, or state government.

Section 3. City Attorney. The City, by and through its governing authority, hereby acknowledges that it has had its legal counsel review the Agreement and that the members of the governing authority itself have reviewed the Agreement and further acknowledge that any rule of construction to the effect that any ambiguities are to be resolved against the drafting party shall not be employed in the interpretation of the Agreement.

Section 4. Repealer. All motions, orders, ordinances, bylaws, resolutions, and parts thereof

inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed as reviving any motion, order, ordinance, bylaw, resolution, or part thereof.

Section 5. Effective Date: Severability. This resolution shall become effective immediately, and should the Agreement have been executed by the Mayor or designee before the effective date of this resolution, then this resolution shall stand as an official act of the governing authority of the City approving of such execution of the Agreement. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision hereof be held invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability thereof shall not affect the remaining provisions hereof.
