COUNCIL MEETING
NOVEMBER 2, 2020**

The Chatsworth City Council met in regular session on Monday, November 2, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. in the council Chambers of City Hall with Mayor K. W. Gong presiding.

PRESENT: Mayor K. W. Gong, Aldermen: Rhett Griffin, Terry Crump, Jeff Cloer and Fred Welch. City Attorney Steve Williams and City Clerk Wilma Nolan.

Mayor Gong called the meeting to order and presented the minutes of the previous meeting and the agenda for the current meeting.

Pam Harris is present to address the council regarding the closing of Market Street from Third Avenue to Second Avenue on Saturday, November 14, 2020, during the hours of 12 Noon to 7:00 p.m.

Presentation of a resolution concerning the closing of an unopened street.

The following petition was presented by Paul and Denise Parker.

PETITION TO CLOSE ROAD

Come now, Paul A. Parker and M. Denise Parker, (hereinafter referred to as "Petitioners"), who request that the City of Chatsworth, a municipal corporation of the State of Georgia, declare that a portion of Elm Street located in Land Lot 229 of the 9th District and 3rd Section of Murray County, Georgia, lying between the east right of way of 10th Avenue (60 feet right of way unopened) and the west right of way of Pemotoma Way (40 feet right of way) shown on the attached Exhibit "A" as Elm Street (50 feet right of way, unopened) be abandoned so as to no longer be a part of the Municipal Street System of the City of Chatsworth and that the rights of the public in and to said street or section thereof, as a public road or street, be terminated, to-wit:

1.

Petitioners are the Owners of real estate contiguous to the road or section thereof requested to be closed.

2.

The Road or section of street thereof which Petitioners request the City of Chatsworth, through its Mayor and City Council, to declare abandoned serves no substantial public purpose.

3.

The City of Chatsworth, a municipal corporation of the State of Georgia, has authority pursuant to O.C.G.A. §32-7-2(c) to declare a road, street or portion thereof abandoned for public purposes and to certify the taking of such action upon its minutes after notice to property owners located thereon and upon determination that the section of said road or street for any reason has ceased to be used by the public to the extent that no substantial public purpose is served by it and after publication required by law and a public hearing on the issue and, upon such declaration and certification, the rights of the public in and to said road or section thereof as a public road shall cease.

4.

WHEREFORE, Petitioners request that such notice as is required by law be given to property owners located thereon and to the public of Petitioners' request; that the City of Chatsworth, a municipality of the State of Georgia, by and through its Mayor and City Council, proceed to declare said road/street or portion thereof no longer a part of the Municipal Street System and certify the abandonment thereof upon its minutes; that the rights of the public in and to said portion of said street as a public road or street cease; and that a deed for said section of said street be delivered to adjoining property owners in accordance with provision of O.C.G.A. §32-7-4.

RESOLUTION TO CLOSE ROAD/STREET

WHEREAS, The City of Chatsworth, a municipality of the State of Georgia by and through its Mayor and City Council, has authority pursuant to O.C.G.A. §32-7-2(c) to declare a road/street or any portion thereof abandoned for public purposes and to certify the taking of such action upon its minutes after notice to the public and property owners located thereon of such proposed actions, a public hearing on such proposed action, and a determination of fact that said road/street or portion thereof no longer serves a substantial public purpose as part of the Municipal Street System; and,

WHEREAS, upon such declaration and certification, the rights of the public in and to said road/street or portion thereof as a public road/street ceases; and

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the City of Chatsworth by and through its Mayor and City Council, after receipt of Petition to close road/street filed by Paul A. Parker and M. Denise Parker, a portion of Elm Street shown on the attached Exhibit "A" being that portion bounded on the east by the west right of way of Pemotoma Way and bounded on the west by the east right of way of 10th Avenue (unopened), serve no substantial public purpose such that the same should be declared abandoned for public purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, let notice of this Resolution be given to the public and to affected property owners as required by law. Notice shall include publication once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks in The Chatsworth Times, the legal organ for publication of Sheriff's notice in Murray County, Georgia, said citation to notify all person that at the regular meeting of The Mayor and City Council of the City of Chatsworth, Georgia, scheduled for the 7th day of December, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the City Hall of the City of Chatsworth, Georgia, that any interested party show cause why said road/street or portion thereof should not be declared closed for public purposes and abandoned as a section of the Municipal Street System of the City of Chatsworth such that the rights of the public in and to said road or portion thereof as a public road shall cease.
