**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF CHATSWORTH, GEORGIA TO EXEMPT CERTAIN
TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY FROM AD VALOREM
TAXATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to *O.C.G.A. §48-5-48.2*, the electors of a political subdivision of the State of Georgia may grant an exemption from *ad valorem* taxation on certain tangible personal property located within the political subdivision; and

WHEREAS, a special election was held and the majority of electors within Murray County approved the implementation of an exemption from *ad valorem* taxation, including all such taxes levied for educational purposes and for state purposes, upon certain tangible personal property located within the City of Chatsworth; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council for the City of Chatsworth desire to set the rate of said *ad valorem* tax exemption, as provided by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT HEREBY IS RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council for the City of Chatsworth, as follows:

-1-

Commencing on January 1, 2023, one hundred percent (100%) of the value of the tangible personal property described in paragraph 2 of this Resolution and located within the City of Chatsworth shall be exempted from *ad valorem* taxation by the City.

-2-

The categories of tangible personal property subject to said tax exemption are as follows:

- (a) Inventory of goods in process of manufacture or production which shall include all partly finished goods and raw materials held for direct use or consumption in the ordinary course of the taxpayer's manufacturing or production business in this state. This exemption shall apply only to tangible personal property which is substantially modified, altered, or changed in the


ordinary course of the taxpayer's manufacturing or production business in this state.

- (b) Inventory of finished goods manufactured or produced within this state in the ordinary course of the taxpayer's manufacturing or production business when held by the original manufacturer or producer of such finished goods. This exemption shall be for a period not exceeding 12 months from the date such property is produced or manufactured.
- (c) Inventory of finished goods which, on January 1, are stored in a warehouse, dock, or wharf, whether public or private, and which are destined for shipment to a final destination outside this state, and inventory of finished goods which are shipped into this state from outside this state and stored for transshipment to a final destination outside this state. This exemption shall be for a period not exceeding 12 months from the date such property is stored in this state.

-3-

The City Clerk is hereby requested to transmit a certified copy of this Resolution to the Georgia State Department of Revenue.
