



Cherokee Regional Library System Kindle Borrower Agreement

The Cherokee Regional Library System is now offering Amazon Kindles for checkout. The Kindle is a convenient, portable reading device with the ability to wirelessly download books, blogs, magazines, and newspapers. Exclusive Kindle features now include Goodreads integration, Kindle Free-Time, Vocabulary Builder, Word Wise and more. A single charge can last up to one month, but battery life will vary based on wireless usage. **The Kindle requires a personal credit card to access certain materials not provided by the Cherokee Regional Library System. To ensure privacy of passwords and other sensitive data, each Kindle will be re-registered to the library upon return.**

- Kindles may be checked out at the Circulation Desk on a first come first served basis. A valid **PINES Library card**, current and in good standing, **as well as a photo ID** such as a Drivers' License, Georgia ID card, or school/college ID **is required each time a Kindle is checked out.**
- Borrowers must be 18 years or older.
- Kindles may be checked out for one week
- The cost of lost or damaged Kindles will be charged to the patron in full, under State Statute § 20-5-52
- Patron must be willing to enter his/her own credit card information in order to add content not already loaded on the device.
- Replacement costs include: replacement of entire device \$150.00; replacement of USB cord \$15.00; and library processing fees of \$10.00.

I, _____ (Please print your name) have read and understand the Kindle agreement and agree that I will be responsible to pay all replacement costs if the Kindle is lost, stolen, or damaged during my checkout period, or if Library Staff identifies any such damage during inspection upon my return of the Kindle. I agree that I will be the exclusive user of the Kindle during my checkout period and that I will not loan, sell, lease, or transfer to anyone else, nor "hack" it in any manner. Furthermore, I agree to not display or download onto the Kindle any graphic material that would be considered offensive. I understand that any failure on my part to comply with the stipulations of this agreement and the guidelines given may result in the suspension of my Kindle access privileges. I understand that, according to Georgia Code 20-5-52 and Georgia Code 20-5-53, the unlawful taking and/or destruction of library materials, as well as failure to return items borrowed from the library, is deemed a misdemeanor under the law.
