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## Biographical Note

Rebekah Slaton Wilson was born on April 18, 1923 in Dawsonville, Georgia. Her parents were Joseph Clayton Slaton and Kate Summerour. She had two sons, Steven Wilson born in 1947 and Calvin Wilson born in 1954. Rebekah was a native and lifelong resident of Dawson County and a retired school teacher, having taught in the Dawson and Forsyth County school systems. Rebekah was a member of the Eastern Star and Concord Baptist Church. She was also well known for her historical and genealogical research for Dawson County. Rebekah died on September 4, 1990 in Dawsonville, Georgia. This collection was donated to the Dawson County Library by her sons Calvin and Steven, in 1990.
