Re: UPDATE TO ATV THEFT

This update is in regards to the release on 1/30/14 regarding the theft of the ATV & trailer from Woodlawn Street.

On Friday- January 31, 2014, Mansfield Police received information that Jackson Shoalmire was the person who had stolen the ATV and trailer, and the items were located on property owned by Shoalmires' family on Hwy# 509 near I.P. This information was relayed to the DeSoto Parish Sheriff's Office for follow-up. Sheriff's investigators were familiar with the location of the property from having dealt with Shoalmire on previous investigations. Sheriff's investigators were able to locate the stolen trailer on the property and while they were examining the trailer, Shoalmire along with his girlfriend, Gennie Wood, and another 16 year old juvenile drove up. Shoalmire spotted the authorities and attempted to flee the area. He was apprehended at the scene and provided a statement admitting to taking the ATV and trailer. Shoalmire stated that the ATV was on a trail in a wooded area adjacent to where the stolen trailer was located. Shoalmire directed authorities to the exact location he left the ATV.

Sheriff's investigators along with Mansfield Police searched the wooded area but were unable to locate the ATV. At this point it is believed that the ATV was stolen from that location.

Jackson Shoalmire, 20 years old, was booked into the DeSoto Parish Detention Center for Felony Theft over \$1500. Gennie wood was booked for Obstruction of Justice.
