Re: Wanted Suspect

On *Sunday-December 21, 2014* at approx. 10:15pm the Mansfield Police Department received a complaint from a citizen reporting that Korry Wyatt had made threats against him and his girlfriend and they feared for their safety. Wyatt arrived at the police station shortly thereafter and became verbally aggressive towards the subject. Officers separated the two of them and advised Wyatt to have a seat while they completed their investigation.

Wyatt did not comply with the Officers request and left the station. After completing their initial investigation, the Officers were able to locate Wyatt at a residence on Myra Street. Officers attempted to place Wyatt under arrest and he resisted their attempts and fled on foot. The Officers pursued Wyatt, and one of the Officers located him in a vacant lot about a block away on Mary Jane Blvd. Wyatt was placed under arrest and handcuffed. While escorting him back to the police unit, Wyatt started physically resisting the Officer and not complying with his commands. During this struggle Wyatt was able to remove the Officers' service weapon from his holster and flee on foot. All available officers, as well as Deputies and a K-9 unit from DeSoto S.O., were called to the scene to attempt to locate Wyatt.

Shortly thereafter, Wyatt's mother came to the Mansfield Police Station and turned over the Officers' service weapon. She indicated that she located Wyatt in the area and was able to talk him in to turning over the weapon but he refused to turn himself in.

Warrants were obtained for Korry Wayne Wyatt, 34 year old black male of Mansfield, for Simple Assault, Disarming of a Police Officer, Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon and Resisting an Officer.

Wyatt has an extensive criminal record dating back to 1997 and is currently on parole until June 2020 for drug convictions. Anyone with information on Wyatt's whereabouts is urged to contact the Mansfield Police Department at 318-872-0520.
