Re: Home Invasion Arrest

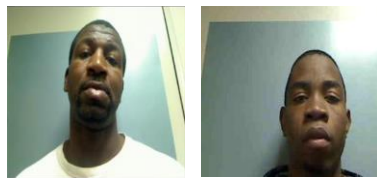
On *Monday- September 14, 2015 at approx. 6:25am* Mansfield Police were called to the 900 block of Johnson Street to a report of a home invasion. Upon arrival Officers discovered that two black males had entered the residence and attacked the male occupant inside the residence.

The victim was transported to University Health where he was treated for his injuries and released. The victim was able to identify his attackers.

Arrest warrants were issued for Lakendrick Lane and Demario Lane for Home Invasion and Aggravated Second Degree Battery.

Demario Lane, 32 year old black male of Mansfield, was arrested later that day and booked into the DeSoto Parish Detention Center.

On *Tuesday- September 15, 2015* Mansfield Police received a report that Lakendrick Lane was located in Desoto Estates. Upon arrival of officers, Lane fled the scene in a vehicle and refused to stop for Officers. Lane led Mansfield Police and DeSoto Sheriff's Deputies through several neighborhoods travelling in excessive speeds. Eventually Lane, 31 year old black male of Mansfield, was apprehended and booked on the outstanding warrants and flight from an officer.
