Re: LAMARCUS FORD ARREST

On Thursday- February 6, 2014 at approx. 11:30pm Mansfield Police were dispatched to the 1100 block of Pegues Street in regards to a home invasion. While en-route to the scene Officers learned that the suspect had fled from the residence on foot and they were provided with the identity of the suspect. Officers encountered the suspect as he was attempting to leave the scene in his vehicle. Officers attempted to stop the suspect and he refused to comply. Suspect then led Officers on a vehicle pursuit, which ended in the 1500 block of Florence Street, where the suspect exited his vehicle and fled again on foot. Officers located the suspect behind a residence and he refused to comply with their orders to surrender. Officers then deployed their TASER to gain control of the suspect.

The suspect, Lamarcus Ford, 31 year old black male of Mansfield, was booked into the DeSoto Parish Detention Center for Home Invasion, Criminal Property Damage, Aggravated Flight from an Officer along with multiple traffic violations related to the vehicle pursuit.
