**MINUTES OF *REGULAR* PUBLIC MEETING**  
**June 26, 2023**

**In-Person Council Meeting**

The Board of Aldermen met in *regular* session on **June 26, 2023**, in Mansfield City Hall located at 705 Polk Street. Mayor Thomas Jones, Jr. called this meeting to order at **4:33 p.m.**, after which an Invocation was offered by **MAYOR** Thomas Jones Jr. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by **Alderwoman Mary Green**.
