A. Conduct a public hearing to hear and discuss any comments related to proposed Ordinance 3 of 2024 authorizing the issuance by the City of Mansfield, State of Louisiana, of its taxable revenue bonds, series 2024, in the amount of one million one hundred thirty thousand dollars (\$1,130,000), prescribing the form, terms, and conditions of said bonds; providing for the payment thereof; entering into certain other covenants and agreements in connection with the security and payment of said bonds; said bonds to be sold to the drinking water revolving loan fund; authorizing the execution of a loan and pledge agreement and other loan documents with the Louisiana department of health; providing for the delivery of the bonds to said department; and providing for other related matters in connection therewith.

A. Approve a CEA with the DeSoto Parish Police Jury to provide safe two-way traffic for Mouton St. and Adams St. by placing curb and gutter, widening portions of each street, and placing defined parking spaces; as the City's road right-of-way was damaged or removed as part of the demolition of the old Jail site and is currently remains with a temporary state with barriers and temporary stone.
