Summer Tax Collection

- Taxes are due September 14th, 2022
- 3% late fee will be added on September 15th, 2022.
- **If you want a mailed receipt, make sure to check the box on the bottom of the tax bill. If no box is checked, no receipt will be mailed.**
- Taxes can be paid by the following methods:
 - Left in drop box
 - In person during office hours
 - By Mail
 - Online- www.ovidmi.org
 - Credit card has 3% fee with \$2/min
 - E-Check has \$3 fee
 - Fees are charge by 3rd party processor

Summer taxes may be deferred until February 14, 2023 if your 2021 total household income did not exceed \$40,000 and you meet one of the following requirements:

- 62 years of age or older
- Hemiplegic, Paraplegic, or Quadriplegic
- Eligible Serviceperson, Eligible Veteran, Eligible Widow or Widower
- Blind
- Total and permanently Disabled

Applications for deferment are available at the City office and must be returned by September 15th, 2022.

BRUSH PICKUP

- Mondays – April 1st thru November 1st.
- No longer than 10ft in length.
- Individual pieces less than 50 lbs.

LEAF PICKUP

- 1st of October through 1st of December, or first snow fall, whichever is first.
- Leaves need to be piled in right of way, not in the road.
- No garbage or yard waste.

LARGE ITEM PICKUP REMAINING DATES:

- August 5th
- October 7th

The recycling center is located in the parking lot across from the City office. **Cardboard is not accepted. Items must be put in the bins. Do not leave trash around bins.**
