Resolution to Allow Local Residents to Protest in Writing

WHEREAS: at a regular meeting of the City Council for the City of Ovid, held on the 8th, day of February, 2021 at 7:00 p.m., with the following Council Members present:

A motion was made by Mr. Brown, seconded by Mr. Williams, to adopt the following resolution:

Moved by Mr. Brown, supported by Mr. Williams, the adoption of the following resolution.

Whereas, MCL 211.30(8), permits a City to authorize a resident taxpayer to file their appeal before the Board of Review by letter without a personal appearance by the taxpayer or their agent.

NOW, Therefore, be it resolved that: In order to ease the burden on taxpayers, the assessor and the board of review and to ensure that all taxpayers have an equal opportunity to be heard by the board of review, the City of Ovid hereby resolves, according to provisions of MCL 211.30(8) of the General Property Tax Act, that the board of review shall receive letters or emails of protest regarding assessments from resident and non-resident taxpayers from the first Tuesday in March until it adjourns from the public hearings for which it meets to hear such protests.

All notices of assessment change and all advertisements of board of review meetings are to include a statement that the resident and non-resident taxpayers may protest by letter or email to the board.
