

COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS
CLOUD COUNTY, KANSAS
AUGUST 22, 2022
OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS

Regular session of the August meetings of the Cloud County Board of Commissioners was called to order at 9:00 a.m. on August 22, 2022 in the Commissioners' room at 811 Washington, Concordia, Kansas with Chairman Ron Copple, Members Bill Czapanskiy and Gary Caspers, and County Clerk Shella Thoman present.

County staff attending was: Andy Asch, Highway Administrator; Tonya Sulanka, Health Department Administrator; Mike Hake, Solid Waste Director.

Others attending: Toby Nosker, KNCK; Josh Meyer, Charles Johnson & Brad Berk, Public Building Commission.

Andy Asch, Highway Administrator discussed applying for the Off-System Bridge and the Local Bridge Improvement programs through the Kansas Department of Transportation. Started spraying for Sericea.

Brad Berk (by phone), Josh Meyer, & Charles Johnson Public Building Commission discussed the Conversion information for the Public Building Bonds. The Public Building Board made a motion to approve the changes.

On a motion by Commissioner Czapanskiy, second by Commissioner Caspers, unanimous vote the Board approved the Chairman signing the Conversion Date Certificate for taxable bonds to be converted from bonds bearing interest at the taxable interest rate of 2.92% to bonds bearing interest at the tax-exempt interest rate of 2.20% effective October 15, 2022.

Mike Hake, Solid Waste Director discussed the changes for Commercial and Demolition/Construction landfill fees. Residents will continue to be \$11.00 month; Business types 1 - \$14.00 monthly; Business type 2 - \$33.00 monthly; Business type 3 - \$53.00 monthly; Business type 4 - \$73.00 monthly; Business type 5 - \$105.00 monthly; Demolition/Construction - \$40.00 per ton; and Municipal Solid Waste - \$74.00 per ton effective October 1, 2022.

On a motion by Commissioner Czapanskiy, second by Commissioner Caspers, unanimous vote the Board approved Resolution 2022-17 changing the commercial and demolition/construction landfill fees.

Tonya Sulanka, Health Department Administrator reported the Glasco Bike Rodeo was a great success and the highest turnout of any Bike Rodeo held in Cloud County. Received a \$1,000 Maternal Child Health grant and will be ordering more helmets and bike gear. They will have a table at Cloud County Community College's Activities and Career fair this week.

On a motion by Commissioner Czapanskiy, second by Commissioner Caspers, unanimous vote the Board approved the classification change for Kyah Summers from CNA \$ 12.52 hourly to CNA/HHA at \$14.00 hourly effective August 29, 2022.

On a motion by Commissioner Caspers, second by Commissioner Czapanskiy, unanimous vote the Board approved hiring Kyle J. Newville as a full-time Deputy at an introductory wage of \$17.00 effective August 29, 2022 to fill an open position.

On a motion by Commissioner Caspers, second by Commissioner Czapanskiy, unanimous vote the Board approved appointing Gary Caspers as the voting delegate and Ron Cople as alternate for the annual KWORCC Board meeting at the Kansas Association of Counties (KAC) conference on October 17, 2022.

On a motion by Commissioner Caspers, second by Commissioner Czapanskiy, unanimous vote the Board approved nominating Sandy Barton, Stanton County Clerk - Southwest District; Linda Buttron, Jefferson County Clerk - Northeast District; and Greg Riat, Pottawatomie County Commissioner – At-large as KWORCC Trustees.
