

COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS
CLOUD COUNTY, KANSAS
DECEMBER 19, 2022
OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS

Regular session of the December meetings of the Cloud County Board of Commissioners was called to order at 9:00 a.m. on December 19, 2022 in the Commissioners' room at 811 Washington, Concordia, Kansas with Chairman Ron Copple, Members Bill Czapanskiy and Gary Caspers, and County Clerk Shella Thoman present.

County staff attending was: Andy Asch, Highway Administrator; and Nancy Owen, Deputy Appraiser.

Others attending: Toby Nosker, KNCK; Mark Matthew; and Nicki Reed, CloudCorp Director.

Andy Asch, Highway Administrator discussed the Skyview Windfarm Road agreement and informed the Board that the UP Bridge was selected for replacement through the States program; the County has 2 years from the date of the letter to have a contract in place. The total project is approximately \$4.6 million with approximately \$585,000 of the funding coming from the County.

Nancy Owen, Deputy Appraiser discussed the abatement process.

Nicki Reed, Cloud Corp Director updated the Board on Cloud Corp's services and discussed the 2023 agreement. The agreement includes a \$58,000 payment for services rendered.

On a motion by Commissioner Czapanskiy, second by Commissioner Caspers, unanimous vote the Board approved signing the 2023 Professional Services Agreement with CloudCorp.

Shella Thoman, County Clerk presented an application for a Cereal Malt Beverage License, a notice will be sent to the Lincoln Township Board for approval.

On a motion by Commissioner Caspers, second by Commissioner Czapanskiy, unanimous vote the Board approved signing the contract with Pawnee Mental Health for 2023 including a distribution totaling \$87,290.00.

The Board recognized the resignation of Spencer Edwards effective December 2, 2022; Easton Hake effective December 15, 2022; and Austin Howard effective December 16, 2022.

On a motion by Commissioner Czapanskiy, second by Commissioner Caspers, unanimous vote the Board approved the Chairman to sign the Quit Claim Deed for right away to Ballou Land and Cattle, Inc. in the amount of \$500.00.

On a motion by Commissioner Czapanskiy, second by Commissioner Caspers, unanimous vote the Board approved abatements 2022-163, 2022-165 thru 2022-170, 2022-172 thru 2022-180 with a net change of (\$1,875.32) and refund of \$1,058.94.

On a motion by Commissioner Caspers, second by Commissioner Czapanskiy, unanimous vote the Board approved the December 12, 2022 minutes as presented.

On a motion by Commissioner Czapanskiy, second by Commissioner Caspers, unanimous vote the Board adjourned at 11:23 a.m., until Thursday December 29, 2022.
