

COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS
CLOUD COUNTY, KANSAS
JUNE 10, 2024
OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS

Regular session of the June meetings of the Cloud County Board of Commissioners was called to order at 9:00 a.m. on June 10, 2024 in the Commissioners' room at 811 Washington, Concordia, Kansas with Chairman Gary Caspers, Members Michael Cleveland and Ron Copple, and County Clerk Shella Thoman present.

County staff attending was: Rod Michaud, Interim Highway Administrator ; Mike Hake, Solid Waste Director; Tonya Sulanka, Health Department Administrator; JoDee LeDuc, Treasurer; Ken Davis, Sheriff; Kim Winsett, County Appraiser; James Quillen, Emergency Preparedness Director; Jana Roush, Register of Deeds; Jeff Thoman, Maintenance Manager; and James Belden, Undersheriff.

Rod Michaud, Interim Highway Administrator and Jon Markel, Kirkham Michael discussed the UP Bridge.

On a motion by Commissioner Copple, second by Commissioner Cleveland, unanimous vote the Board approved a 10-minute executive session for land acquisition to discuss the UP Bridge resuming open session at 9:28 a.m., including Jon Markel, Kirkham Michael; Rod Michaud, and Thoman.

On a motion by Commissioner Copple, second by Commissioner Cleveland, unanimous vote the Board approved a 10-minute executive session for personnel exception to discuss non-elected personnel resuming open session at 9:56 a.m., including Michaud and Thoman.

Casey Fraser and Ryan Standley, Foley Tractor presented an estimate for rapid reporting in equipment. Michaud will review the equipment list and report back on what equipment needs reporting.

On a motion by Commissioner Cleveland, second by Commissioner Copple, unanimous vote the Board approved the request and petition for Linda or Mike Richard or Aaron J. Richard with Oakland Farms for a waterline across Acorn east of 200th Road.

The Board recognized the classification change for Christine Witt from Intensive Supervision Office to Assistant Director/Intensive Supervision Officer including a wage change from \$34.17 to \$39.56 effective June 9, 2024.
