CITY COUNCIL WORKSHOP MINUTES
JUNE 23RD, 2022

Members of the City Council of the City of Crawford, Nebraska, met in a workshop session in the Crawford City Hall Council Chambers, 135 Elm Street, Crawford, Nebraska on the 23rd day of June, 2022, at 6:00 o'clock p.m. The following individuals were present: Mayor Connie Shell, Council Member Ed Kuhnel, Council Member Ronnie Thompson, Council Member Susan Leeling and Council Member Zac Riggs. Absent: Attorney Adam Edmund.

Notice of the workshop was given in advance thereof by publishing in The Crawford Clipper/Harrison Sun as shown by the affidavit of publication filed in the City Clerk's office at City Hall and by posting in three public places as shown by the Certificate of Posting available at the City Clerk's office at City Hall. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice of the Mayor and City Council of this meeting. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.


Mayor Shell called the workshop to order and declared a quorum present at 6:00 p.m. and announced to the public that a copy of the Open Meetings Act is posted on the wall in the Council Chambers. It is also available in pamphlet form.


Discussion was held on the Garbage, Community Building, Fire and Public Transportation funds. Two of the three HVAC systems at the community building should be replaced. The capital improvement plan for public transportation still includes a vehicle, but the one from NDOT covid funds should be available in 2023, hopefully. Consensus of the Council was to not pursue the electronic sign for public transportation at this time. The carport or garage for public transportation is still on the capital improvement plan. There were thoughts to do it in a way to allow for future additions to accommodate other vehicles and storage. April Grant offered to help with estimates.

Other items to remember about next fiscal year's budget: municipal equalization is projected to be \$30,000 less than the current year. Regarding insurance rates, the work comp "Mod Factor" is .86, which is very good. We need to continue to remember to address the deficit in the Golf fund.

Plans are to address the General, Water and Waste Water funds on June 30, 2022.

The June 23, 2022 workshop of the City Council adjourned at 7:20 p.m.
