AUGUST 11, 2022


Notice of the workshop was given in advance thereof by publishing in The Crawford Clipper/Harrison Sun as shown by the affidavit of publication filed in the City Clerk's office at City Hall and by posting in three public places as shown by the Certificate of Posting available at the City Clerk's office at City Hall. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice of the Mayor and City Council of this meeting. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Mayor Shell called the workshop to order at 6:07 p.m. and announced to the public that a copy of the Open Meetings Act is posted on the wall in the Council Chambers. It is also available in pamphlet form.


The Council discussed the FYE 2023 budget for all funds. The law enforcement contract decreased by \$1,216 from the current year. The total of the city wages was reviewed and appeared pretty close to what was budgeted, with overtime always being uncertain. Some adjustments were made and a balanced budget was attained. Some miscellaneous items included double-checking the amortization charts for debt/interest, trying to estimate if Fisher Roofing will complete their work this fiscal year, no real interest in selling the American Tower lease, possible options to address the golf deficit, some golf prices should be increased, and no interest in pursuing the hearing process to exceed allowable growth in property taxes.

The August 11, 2022 workshop of the City Council adjourned at approximately 7:15 p.m.
