## CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES

### COUNCIL BUDGET HEARING

SEPTEMBER 20, 2022

Members of the City Council of the City of Crawford, Nebraska, met in special session in the Crawford City Hall Council Chambers, 135 Elm Street, Crawford, Nebraska on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2022 at 5:00 o'clock p.m. The following individuals were present: Mayor Connie Shell, Council Member Ronnie Thompson, Council Member Susan Leeling and Council Member Zac Riggs. Council Member Ed Kuhnel entered the meeting at 5:09 p.m. Absent: Attorney Edmund.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publishing in The Crawford Clipper/Harrison Sun as shown by the affidavit of publication filed in the City Clerk's office at City Hall. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice of the Mayor and City Council of this meeting. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Mayor Shell called the meeting to order and declared a quorum at 5:05 p.m. and announced to the public that a copy of the Open Meetings Act is posted on the wall in the Council Chambers. It is also available in pamphlet form.


The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Open Hearing for the Proposed Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Budget opened at 5:07 p.m. Mayor Shell explained the Special Hearing was held to set the Final Tax Request (this is outlined in 77-1632). Mayor Shell explained that the water project and insurance claims from last year have been finalized and were removed from this budget. She explained that the ARP Funds will be used for streets, pool and two new HVAC system for the community building. Mayor Shell shared that the additional \$150,000 was for the grant to purchase additional green dumpster to be used for the City of Crawford. She also explained that Ponderosa Budget of \$2,557,750 was also added. After some discuss from both the council and the public, the hearing closed at 5:18 p.m.


