**CITY COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING MINUTES**  
**NOVEMBER 8, 2022**

Members of the City Council of the City of Crawford, Nebraska, met in regular session in the Crawford City Hall Council Chambers, 135 Elm Street, Crawford, Nebraska on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2022, at 5:30 o'clock p.m. The following individuals were present: Mayor Connie Shell, Council Member Ed Kuhnel, Council Member Ronnie Thompson, Council Member Susan Leeling and Council Member Zac Riggs. Absent: Attorney Adam Edmund.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publishing in The Crawford Clipper/Harrison Sun as shown by the affidavit of publication filed in the City Clerk's office at City Hall. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice of the Mayor and City Council of this meeting. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Mayor Shell called the meeting to order and declared a quorum present at 5:30 p.m. and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Mayor Shell announced to the public that a copy of the Open Meetings Act is posted on the wall in the Council Chambers. It is also available in pamphlet form.

Council Member Kuhnel made a motion to approve the minutes of the October 25, 2022 regular council meeting and to excuse the absence of Council Member Riggs from the October 25, 2022 regular council meeting. The motion was seconded by Council Member Leeling. The following Council Members voted AYE: Kuhnel, Leeling, Thompson and Riggs. Council Members voted NAY: None. Motion carried.

Ponderosa Villa: Stacie Jones reported that there are 23 in the nursing home and 9 in assisted-living. They gave two tours for assisted-living. There have been a couple of referrals on the nursing home side. They currently have some covid cases.

Council Member Riggs made a motion to approve the zoning permits for Mike Bowman for a garage and fence at 128 Linn Street, Janet Mize for a shed at 819 Seventh Street, Bob & Deb Pickering for a shed at 505 Elm Street and Kimberly Wiseman for a fence at 105 Linn Street. The motion was seconded by Council Member Kuhnel. The following Council Members voted AYE: Riggs, Kuhnel, Thompson and Leeling. Council Members voted NAY: None. Motion carried.

Mayor Shell stated that the Chamber of Commerce would like a Christmas tree to place at the intersection of Second and Elm Streets, and a tree from the cemetery was mentioned. If approved, Justin Tollman had been advised to work with Tim Schultz on the selection of the tree. If an adequate tree from an acceptable location at the cemetery could not be found, the Chamber will make other arrangements. The tree would be put up after Thanksgiving. There will also be the parade and other usual activities.

Council Member Kuhnel made a motion to approve the Christmas tree and placement at the intersection of Second and Elm Streets. The motion was seconded by Council Member Riggs. The following Council Members voted AYE: Kuhnel, Riggs, Thompson and Leeling. Council Members voted NAY: None. Motion carried.

Council Member Kuhnel made a motion to approve the transfer of \$1,743.87 from medical clinic savings to checking to reimburse for the repairs to the heating and cooling system at the medical clinic. The motion was seconded by Council Member Thompson. The following Council Members voted AYE: Kuhnel, Thompson, Leeling and Riggs. Council Members voted NAY: None. Motion carried.

Council Member Kuhnel made a motion to approve bills, claims and transfers. The motion was seconded by Council Member Riggs. The following Council Members voted AYE: Kuhnel, Riggs, Thompson and Leeling. Council Members voted NAY: None. Motion carried.




