RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CROSBYTON AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A GRANT APPLICATION WITH THE TEXAS DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT FOR THE FEMA PUBLIC ASSISTANCE PROGRAM GRANT DR-4586 (TEXAS SEVERE WINTER STORMS): AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF CROSBYTON IN ALL MATTERS RELATED TO THE APPLICATION; AND PLEDGING THAT IF A GRANT IS RECEIVED THE CITY OF CROSBYTON WILL COMPLY WITH THE GRANT REQUIREMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Texas Division of Emergency Management and FEMA recently approved DR-4586 Public Assistance Program Grant

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Crosbyton that the Public Assistance Program Grant be operated for the 21/22 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City of Crosbyton in the State of Texas is qualified to apply for grant funds under the Request for Applications; and

WHEREAS, the City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Emergency Management Division funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Emergency Management Division in full.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF CROSBYTON, TEXAS;

1. That the Mayor is authorized to request FY 21/22 grant funding under the Texas Division of Emergency Management and act on behalf of the City of Crosbyton in all matters

related to the grant application and any subsequent grant contract and grant project that may result.

2. That if the project is funded, the City of Crosbyton will comply with the grant requirements.
3. The grant funds and any grant-funded equipment will be used only for the purposes for which they are intended under the grant.
