RESOLUTION 04-2021

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CROSBYTON, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FUND; AND AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO ACT AS THE CITY'S AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE(S) IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Crosbyton desires to develop a viable community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low-to-moderate income; and

WHEREAS, certain conditions exist which represent a threat to the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of the City of Crosbyton to apply for funding under the Texas Community Development Block Grant Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CROSBYTON, TEXAS:

1. That a Texas Community Development Block Grant Program application for the Community Development Fund is hereby authorized to be filed on behalf of the City with the Texas Department of Agriculture.
2. That the City's application be placed in competition for funding under the Community Development Fund.
3. That the application be for \$350,000 of grant funds to provide sewer improvements and related sewer activities.
4. That the City Council directs and designates the following to act in all matters in connection with this application and the County's participation in the Texas Community Development Block Grant Program:

- (Mayor, City Manager) shall serve as the County's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to execute this application and any subsequent contractual documents;
 - The Mayor or City Manager is authorized to execute environmental review documents between the Texas Department of Agriculture and the City/County; and
 - If this application is funded, the Mayor or City Manager is authorized to execute the Request for Payment Form documents and/or other forms required for requesting funds to reimburse project costs.
5. That all funds will be used in accordance with all applicable federal, state, local and programmatic requirements including but not limited to procurement, environmental review, labor standards, real property acquisition, and civil rights requirements.
 6. That it further be stated that the City of Crosbyton is committing \$17,500 from its General Fund as a cash contribution toward the engineering fee and construction of this CDBG project.
