Approve Bids for Commercial Garage Door, Framing the Doorway, and Concrete Work at 121 S. Ayrshire for Fire Truck Bay: Brad Thornhill made a motion to approve the \$4,294.00 bid by Action Doors for a commercial garage door, the \$4,400.00 bid by Metal Works for framing the doorway, and the \$11,500.00 bid by Troy Wallace for concrete work at 121 S. Ayrshire for the fire truck bay. Kevin Fry seconded the motion. Vote 6-0, motion passed.

Approve New Sentry Storm Siren- 14v1T \$15,500 or 15v2T \$18,500 and bid for setting of Four New Poles and Mounting of Sirens: James Parkhill made a motion to purchase the 15v2T storm siren for \$18,500. Heidi Hays seconded the motion. Vote 6-0, motion passed.

Approve Hammond Sheet Metal Bid for Replacing Original HVAC Unit at Library: Brad Thornhill made a motion to accept the \$6250.00 bid by Hammond Sheet Metal Bid for Replacing Original HVAC Unit at the Library. Jim Justus seconded the motion. Vote 6-0, motion passed.
