

Called Council Meeting May 24, 2021

Mayor Dusty Cornelius called the meeting to order at 7:07 p.m. with the following council members present: Brad Thornhill, Abel Reyna, James Parkhill, Kevin Fry, Heidi Hays, and Jim Justus. Also present were City Administrator Amy Wallace, and City Secretary Cheyanne Flores.

Swimming Pool Manager: Brad Thornhill made a motion to hire Alva Rodriguez as the Swimming Pool Manager. Abel Reyna seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Swimming Pool- Admission Fees/Party Rental Fees: Kevin Fry made a motion to set the swimming pool admission fee to \$3.00 per person per day with use of a daily sign in sheet, and to set the party rental fee to \$75 per hour and the city retains one-third of the total rental fee. James Parkhill seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Swimming Pool- Lift Chair: Brad Thornhill made a motion that a lift chair be purchased when funds become available. Abel Reyna seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Swimming Pool- Rules and Regulations: Heidi Hays made a motion to adopt the following swimming pool rules, and to include nightly cash drops with the daily sign in sheet. Kevin Fry seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The following City Pool Rules are listed for your convenience so you may be informed prior to your visit. Disregard for these rules can result in bodily harm and/or loss of swim privileges.

1. Obey instruction of lifeguard.
2. Children under the age of nine (9) and anyone who needs floaties must be accompanied by a person (within reach) 16 years of age or older.
3. Must have proper swim attire. (Proper attire: bathing suits, board shorts, or swim shirts made from lycra may be worn. No cotton clothing, no denim, no basketball shorts, no socks.)
4. Patrons may have to demonstrate their swimming abilities before entering the deep end of the pool.
5. You must shower before entering the pool area.
6. Glass containers or glass objects in pool area should remain outside the facility.
7. Smoking or the use of tobacco products is prohibited.
8. No alcoholic beverages (or intoxicated person) and illegal substances.
9. Animals or pets may not enter the pool gate.
10. Business phone is not for public use.
11. No profanity.
12. Running in pool area is not permitted.

13. Handling, pulling, or jumping on the ropes is not allowed.

14. Diving is only allowed on the diving board.

15. Use ladders and steps to exit the pool.

16. Everyone is responsible for picking up their own trash.

WE ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR LOST OR STOLEN ITEMS.

Admission may be refused for any reason, including conduct or behavior that may endanger the health or safety of the public (i.e., open sores, rashes, runny eyes, or nose).
