A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE HOURS AND PLACE FOR HOLDING THE REGULAR ELECTION FOR MAYOR AND THREE ALDERMAN, WARD 1, WARD 2, AND WARD 3 TO BE HELD MAY 2, 2020 AND OTHER MATTERS RELATIVE THERETO.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CROSBYTON, TEXAS:

That the Regular City Election to be held May 2, 2020 pursuant to laws of the State of Texas and the Charter of the City of Crosbyton, Texas shall be held between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., at which time the Polls shall be opened and closed.

Said election shall be held in conjunction with Crosbyton Consolidated Independent School District at the following Polling Place within the City of Crosbyton, Texas:

Crosbyton, Texas

At the election hereby ordered, there shall be elected one (1) Mayor and three (3) Alderman, one (1) Alderman for Ward 1, one (1) Alderman for Ward 2, and one (1) Alderman for Ward 3. Alderman shall be elected by Wards, Alderman Ward one (1), Alderman Ward two (2), Alderman Ward three (3). Alderman will be two-year terms. Applications shall be filed by sworn applications with the City Secretary prior to five o'clock (5:00) p.m. February 14, 2020.

The manner of holding said election shall be governed as near as may be by the General Election Laws of the State of Texas, and Charter of the City of Crosbyton, Texas. The Chief of Police is hereby directed and instructed to post a properly executed copy of this resolution at the City Hall, Crosbyton, Texas. Such posting shall be made at least twenty (20) days before the date of said election.
