Regular Council Meeting March 19, 2019

Also present were City Administer Margot Hardin, City Secretary Amy Wallace, Public Works Director Chase Longo and Elida Rodriguez.

Approve February 19, 2019 Minutes: Abel Reyna made a motion to approve the February 19, 2019 minutes. Doyle Parrish seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Approve February Accounts Payables: Brad Thornhill made a motion to approve the February Accounts Payable, excluding D & H Spraying and Landscape Accounts Payable. Alva Rodriguez seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Approve D&H Spraying and Landscaping Accounts payable: Heidi Hays made a motion to approve D&H Spraying and Landscaping accounts payable. Abel Reyna seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Public Forum: Elida Rodriguez came forward to thank the council as well as the chamber on behalf of her mother. She said her mother is very appreciative of the support she has received on the recent opening of her new business in town. Elida also thanked the public works department for their responsiveness to situations involving power lines due to recent weather incidents.

Whereas, the City of Crosbyton and the Crosby County Pioneer Museum's budgets, appended here as Exhibit A, for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 2019, and ending March 31, 2020, was duly presented to the City Council and a public hearing was ordered by the City Council and a public notice of said hearing was caused to be given by the City Council and said notice was published in the Crosby County News and said public hearing was held according to said notice; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CROSBYTON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the appropriations for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 2019, and ending March 31, 2020, for the support of the general government of the City of Crosbyton, Texas be fixed and determined for said terms in accordance with the expenditures shown in the City's and the Crosby County Pioneer Museum Fiscal Year 2019-20 Budget, a copy of which is appended hereto as Exhibit A;

SECTION 2. That the Budgets, as shown in words and figures in Exhibit A, is hereby approved in all respects and adopted as the City of Crosbyton and the Crosby County Pioneer Museum's Budgets for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 2019, and ending March 31, 2020.

ORDINANCE NO. 03-2019

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BUDGET OF THE CITY OF CROSBYTON, TEXAS,
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR APRIL 1, 2018 THROUGH MARCH 31, 2019.**

WHEREAS, an annual operating budget for the fiscal year April 1, 2018 through March 31, 2019 was approved and adopted by the City Council of the City of Crosbyton, Texas on March 19, 2019.

WHEREAS, amendments to said budget have been deemed necessary as itemized in "Exhibit A" attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, said full and final consideration of said budget amendments been held in a legally posted public meeting of the Crosbyton City Council, and it is the consensus of opinion that the budget amendments as submitted should be approved and adopted.

ARTICLE I
