

Regular Council Meeting November 17, 2020

Mayor Dusty Cornelius called the regular meeting to order at 7:01 p.m. with the following council members present: Brad Thornhill, Alva Rodriguez, Doyle Parrish, Jim Justus, Abel Reyna, and Heidi Hays via ZOOM. Also present were: City Administrator Amy Wallace, Public Works Director Chase Longo, and Chief of Police John Wilson.

Approve October 20, 2020 Minutes: Doyle Parrish made a motion to approve the October 20, 2020 minutes. Abel Reyna seconded the motion. Motion carried.
