RESOLUTION 12-2021

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CROSBYTON AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A GRANT APPLICATION WITH THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION OF THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR FOR A BODY-WORN CAMERA GRANT: AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF CROSBYTON IN ALL MATTERS RELATED TO THE APPLICATION; AND PLEDGING THAT IF A GRANT IS RECEIVED THE CITY OF CROSBYTON WILL COMPLY WITH THE GRANT REQUIREMENTS.

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Crosbyton that the Body-Worn Camera Grant be operated for the 2022 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, that the City Council agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said project as required by the Office of the Governor grant application; and

WHEREAS, the City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Officer of the Governor in full.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF CROSBYTON, TEXAS;

1. That the Mayor is authorized to request FY 2022 grant funding under the Office of the Governor for the Body-Worn Camera grant program and act on behalf of the City of Crosbyton in all matters related to the grant application and any subsequent grant contract and grant project that may result.
2. That the City Council approves submission of the grant application for the Body-Worn Camera Grant to the Office of the Governor.
3. That if the project is funded, the City of Crosbyton will comply with the grant requirements
4. The grant funds and any grant-funded equipment will be used only for the purposes for which they are intended under the grant.
