

1. **Call to Order/Pledge of Allegiance:** Called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Supervisor Larry Grimsby followed by Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.
2. **Roll Call:** Present: Larry Grimsby, Jim Anderson, Bill Helen, Roberta Nuce, Marlene Saari (Deputy Clerk) and 3 guests. Absent: Betty Perkins, excused absence.
3. **Approval of Agenda:** Agenda amended to include Midland Pre-Pay for Fuel and Bill from Daily Globe for ad in paper added to New Business. Motion to approve amended agenda by Hellen, support by Nuce. Carried.
4. **Public Commend on Agenda Items (3-minute limit) – None**
5. **Approval of Minutes:** Motion to approve August 10, 2022 Regular Board Meeting Minutes, as printed, by Anderson, supported by Nuce. Carried.
6. **Consent Agenda:** Gogebic County Board Meeting Minutes and Letter from Erwin Township Historical Society regarding the trail may be on part of the township property. Motion by Grimsby to accept the Consent Agenda, supported by Anderson. Carried.

9. **Supervisor's Comments.**
 - a. Building permits are at 370% of estimated amount.
 - b. ORV Resolution regarding increasing the speed limit previously passed is a dead issue. Michigan State Law states the speed limit is 25 m.p.h. Municipalities cannot exceed that limit. No public hearing will be necessary.
 - c. APEX is operational. Physical structures are shown on APEX. Improvements will be noted on the property cards but not on APEX.

 - a. Tables and chairs. The supervisor has been getting requests from residents asking to rent tables and chairs. Discussion was held on whether the new tables and chairs should be rented and if a policy should be put in place. Item was tabled to next meeting.
