Currently Haley is volunteering, but she has gotten an offer from another city that will pay for her time. There was discussion on trying to come up with funds to compensate her, or charge per senior who attends fitness classes. Ted Wagner suggested requesting funds from City Council. The Senior Center is back to normal hours in September, opening at 9:00 a.m. and all Meals-on-Wheels paperwork is up to date and set to feed 10 on Tuesdays.

Regina gave an update on possible fundraiser for November Market; 50/50 tickets, raffle for the recliner, and a bake sale.

**C. Building Maintenance: dumpster, parking lot striping, window leaks, etc.**

Regina gave an update and there was some discussion by the board. The dumpster is gone. Regina had a meeting with Ben White, City Manager, but does not have a final count on how many parking spots there will be and hopefully will stripe the parking lot soon once the weather cools down. Three of the windows have been replaced, 5 left to be replaced; the Centennial Committee are still waiting on bids for the replacement work. Regina is hopeful that they will get replaced after the Old Time Saturday fundraiser.

Robin mentioned there was a soft spot in the women's restroom in the Civic Center and that it has already been fixed.

- Parking lot striping, would like update from Ben if not complete before next meeting.

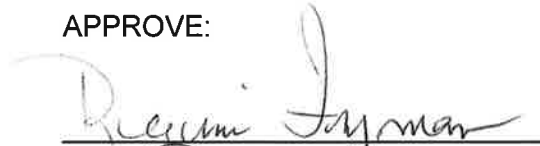
**IX. ADJOURNMENT**
