VIII. ADJOURNMENT

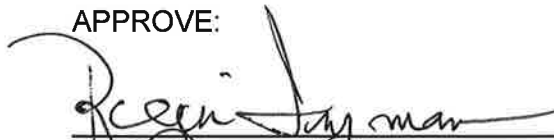
Karen made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Darla seconded; all were in favor. The meeting adjourned at 4:29 p.m.
