I. PRELIMINARY MATTERS

- Mayor Piwko called the meeting to order at 6:00pm. Council members John Klostermann, Donny Mason, Michael Hesse, Mike Hurst, and Leaca Caspari were all present. City staff members Ben White, Chief Mike Sullivan, Chief Kim Morris, Paula Jackson, Rick Ranspot, Adah Leah Wolf, Daphne Hamlin and Trisha Dowell were also present. Prayer was led by Warrant Officer Rick Ranspot followed by pledges to the United States flag and Texas flag.

- Donna Williams, business owner of Red Door Antiques, thanked everyone who worked and helped make the Trick It Up Bike Ride a success this year.

- Mayor Piwko pulled Items A and B
- Item A: City Council Minutes
 - Mayor requested that a bullet item be added under Regular Agenda, item A, that reads that city council has told Mr. Furr there is no electric scada system on the sewer location thus preventing the city from notification of a non-working pump/power outage and Mr. Furr agreed to take responsibility.
 - Piwko also requested an action be stated under item C: Farmersville logo policy, which states staff to create policy for logo. Also under item G, an action be added that states that staff will work with council about creating customized letters to the individuals to approach.

- Leaca Caspari requested that under a previous Consent Agenda; Corrections of Minutes of 09-27-16, a correction be made to state she requested that city attorney make recommendations regarding proper communication of the Mayor and Council with city boards and commissions.

- All council members were in favor thereby approving the changes

Item A: City Manager's Report

- Ben White explained to the Mayor and council about the status of the permit for a fence at Stop and Buy on Main St. and the closing off of Short Street
- Ben asked Mr. Ali to stop work on the fence until more information is acquired. He also explained that the railroad crossing on S. Main St will open on 10-26-16 along with the crossing on Walnut.
- City Manager also updated the council on City Hall reconstruction. He stated that the flooring for downstairs has been delayed until November 5th. Regardless of that delay, Mr. White said that the rewiring and moving of the IT room was possible. Also, other items that will be put into play will be a security system upgrade, related siren and radio systems, possible camera and door access systems, and wiring cabinets for IT.
- There are also a few items city manager said are optional such as new chairs for council and the guest seating, kitchen upgrade for staff, new carpet upstairs, roof insulation and new tiles. He stated however, that since money is a concern. These items may or may not happen this year.
- Ben White also talked about the Main Street Grant the city will be receiving for the downtown ADA and storm water improvements. He states that it appears we have received the grant, we are just waiting for the official letter. Also, Collin County Project Funding Assistance Program awarded \$50,000 for improvements to JW Spain Athletic Complex.
- Mayor Piwko asked about the City Secretary hiring process, to which Ben replied that two interviews are scheduled for the week of the 24th and at that point they should be ready for final interviews.

- 2nd to approve was made Michael Hesse
- All council members were in favor thereby approving the motion

 - All councilmembers were in favor thereby approving motion

 - Mayor Piwko expressed concerns about not having enough to make quorum and not having a chair person.
 - John Klostermann stated that Craig Overstreet is the Vice Chair and is doing a good job
 - Attorney Alan Lathrom stated that if the board wants to reorganize now, they can.
 - Donny Mason withdrew his motion
 - New motion to table the appointment until December meeting was made by Mike Hurst
 - 2nd to approve as made by Leaca Caspari
 - All council members were in favor

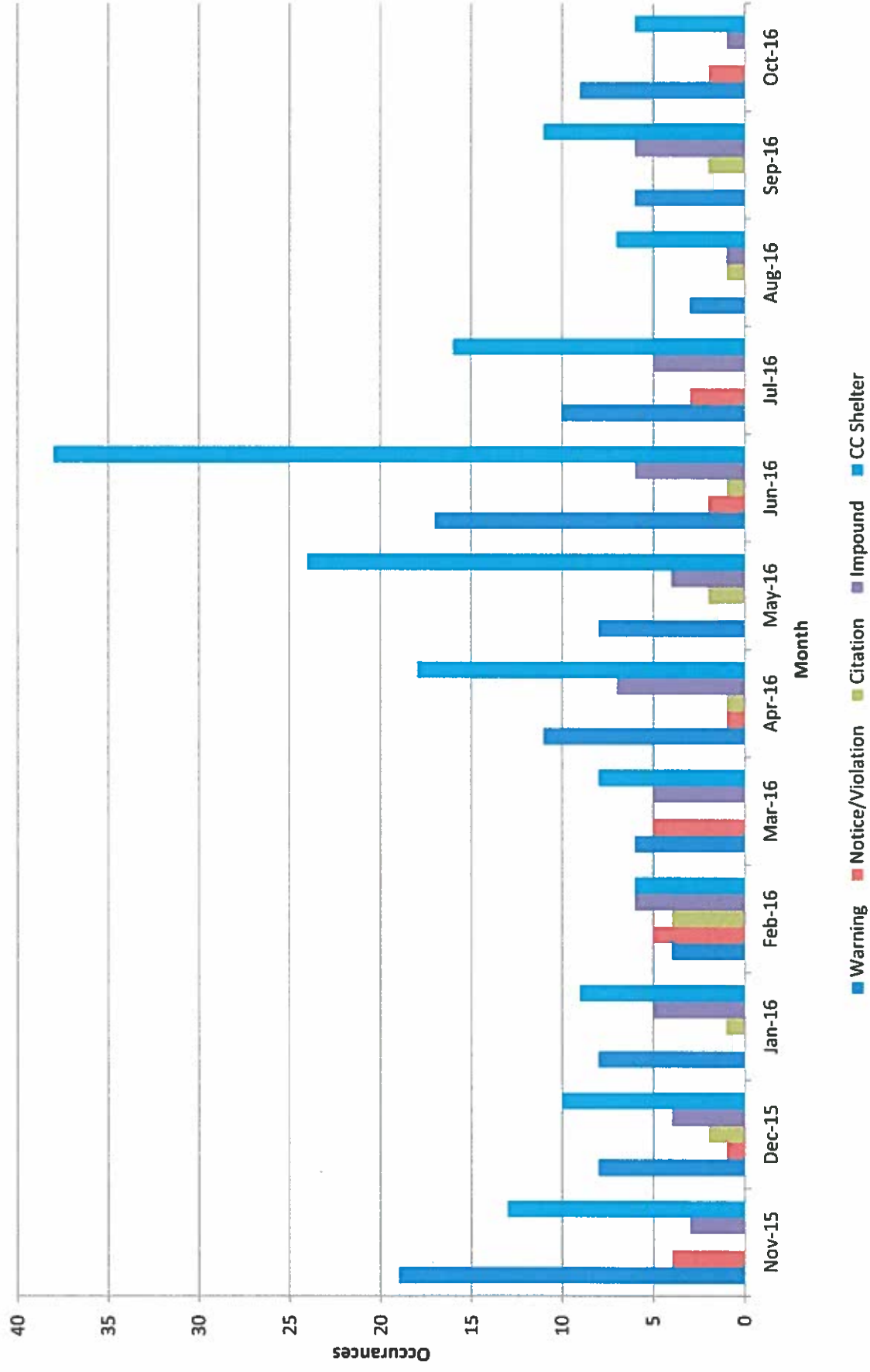

4. Chief Morris attended the Farm Bureau Annual Banquet held in McKinney, TX where he received a \$100 donation to the department.

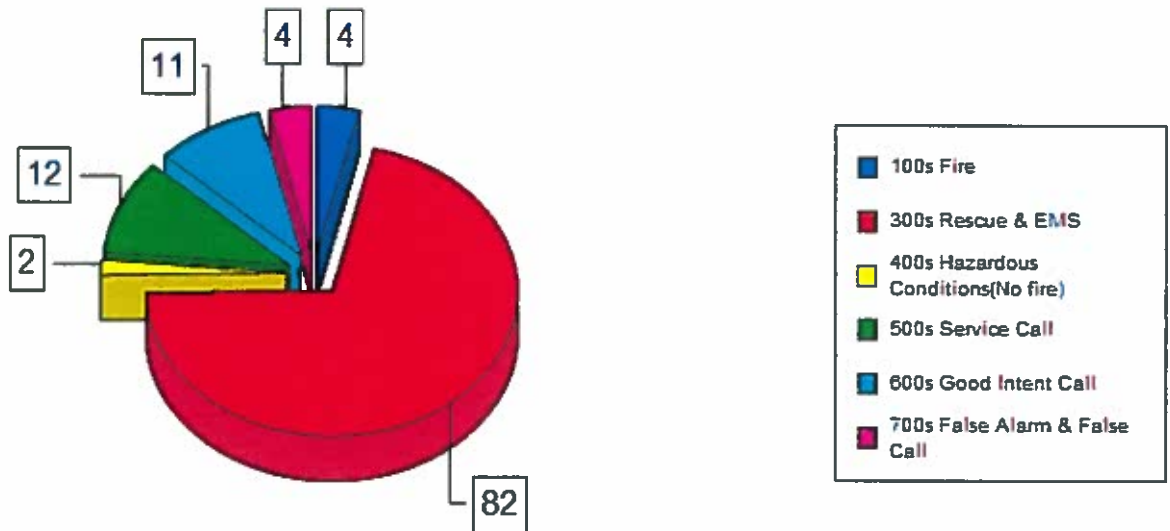

The librarians gave out Halloween candy bags to the children who visited the library on Friday and Saturday, October 28 and 29.

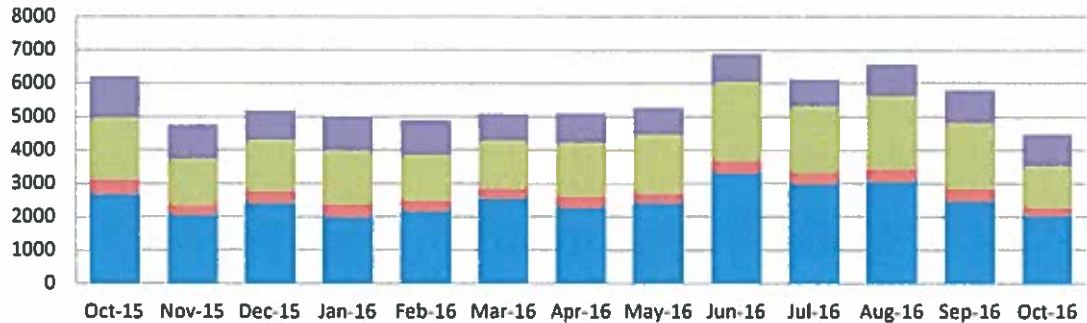
