MUSICAL SERVICES CONTRACT

THE STATE OF TEXAS]
COUNTY OF HUNT]

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into this 28th day of March 2023, by and between **THE BLANDELLES**, hereinafter referred to as "BAND", whose operating address is 10502 Oak Creek Dr. Greenville Tx 75402, and City of Farmersville, hereinafter referred to as "PURCHASER", whose address is _____.

WHEREAS, the BAND operates as a Fifties Rock-n-Roll Group, performing music made famous in the Fifties and Sixties, and WHEREAS the PURCHASER is desirous of having the BAND perform their music for them:

THEREFORE, in consideration of the payment by PURCHASER of the sum of \$1200⁰⁰, payable in Hunt County, Texas as follows, Night of Performance and the covenants and agreements hereinafter contained, the BAND hereby agrees to perform their musical services for PURCHASER.

TERM. This agreement covers the night of June 2, 2023, between the hours of 7-9 PM.

PLACE. PURCHASER shall provide at its own expense an appropriate site for the performance, more specifically described as: Orion Shed pavilion

ASSIGNMENT. This agreement is not assignable by either party without the express writtn consent of both parties to this agreement. Any attempt at assignment of this agreement without the above-mentioned written consent will constitute a breach of this agreement by the party attempting said assignment.

TERMINATION. This agreement may be terminated only upon written notice to the parties of this agreement at the addresses listed above, given at least 10 (ten) days before the performance date.

BREACH. Failure to comply with the terms of this agreement by either party shall be considered a breach of the entire agreement, and the breaching party shall be liable for all reasonable damages incurred as a result of such breach.

LAW. In the event of any dispute between PURCHASER and BAND under the terms of this agreement, venue will be in Hunt County, Texas, and the laws of the State of Texas will be applicable.

ENTIRETY. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and there are no oral or written inducements or agreements except as contained herein.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the PURCHASER or its duly recognized representative and the duly recognized representative of the BAND have signed their names hereto and caused this agreement to be executed.
