## Position Summary:

Responsible for dependable electric service throughout the Farmersville Electric service area including construction, operation, and maintenance of the system's overhead, underground, and lighting components. The duties are carried out in a safe, prompt, efficient, and workmanlike manner. Typically this position will work with direct supervision.

## Duties:

- Construct, operate, and maintain distribution electric system facilities between substation(s) and customers/owners.
- Prepare service requests to identify locations and/or causes of malfunctions or problems.
- Attend on-site and off-site safety training classes as scheduled by supervisor.
- Perform work on all system voltages, distribution lines.
- Repair/replace or assists in the repair/replacement of damaged or overloaded services, secondaries, primaries and transformers.
- Investigate consumer service complaints and outage reports and take appropriate action.
- Make trouble calls to determine the causes of service interruption. Make repairs and report findings to Power System Manager.
- Communicate with employees and customers by phone, in the office and in field locations to handle complaints, disconnects, reconnects, and new service accounts.
- Operate the various types of trucks and equipment associated with construction and maintenance of power lines.
- Patrol lines and make necessary repairs.
- Prepare, process, and otherwise appropriately handle documents or any other paperwork that may be required.
- Required to communicate both orally and written to consumers in such a manner that is clear and understandable.
- Perform work that is consistent with existing management and safety policy.

- Perform the duties of this position before or after regular scheduled work times during emergency situations.
- Perform such other duties as assigned, including duties that may not be required to be performed by a Lineman and duties that may not typically be performed by Lineman.

- Minimum 4 years experience with power line work, construction and transformer loading/banking
