Jon Alt, County Road Superintendent met with the Board to discuss road conditions.

Bill Schneider and Bob Waiter-Red Rock Resort Manager requested that the Red Rock Subdivision be allowed to have year-round residents. It is currently restricted to summer access only. The request is in response to the possible access of Southwest Water Authority pipeline. Chairman Zenker suggested the County Zoning Board hear the appeal first and offer a recommendation.

Dennis Meier, Three Rivers Human Services Board Director would like to use the Nissan Rogue for the Sioux County Human Services area instead of having it in Grant County. Currently Grant County is utilizing the Rogue and Jeep. Reinhardt recommended the Rogue remain in Grant County because it is better suited for the employees that work here to operate. Zenker asked if the vehicle was purchased with state funds or county funds. All are designated as zone vehicles. The Jeep will be utilized by the Zone, and the Rogue will be used by Grant County staff.

Gary Schlosser, Courthouse Maintenance inform the Board of the three quotes for lawn tractors he obtained. Reinhardt made the motion to approve the purchase of the John Deere lawn tractor from Gooseneck Implement. Seconded by Hochhalter. Roll call vote- Reinhardt – aye, Hochhalter– aye, Zenker – aye. Motion carried.
