Commissioner Zenker called the October 6, 2021 meeting of the Grant County Commissioners to order 9:0 a.m. Public present were Shannon Wangsvick, LeAnn Hohertz, Gregory Bruce, and Patrick Diehl.

Moved by Commissioner Reinhardt and seconded by Commissioner Hochhalter to approve agenda. All present voting aye; agenda approved.

Moved by Commissioner Hochhalter and seconded by Commissioner Reinhardt to approve minutes. All present voting aye; minutes approved.

Moved by Commissioner Hochhalter and seconded by Commissioner Reinhardt to approve minutes of the 2022 Budget Hearing held September 16, 2021. All present voting aye; minutes approved.

Old business: Meeting about the assessment agreement with the organized townships and cities to the November 3rd, 2021 meeting. Marissa Sprenger stated that having a group discussion may not make an impact on the agreement. Ms. Sprenger stated that each jurisdiction has a right to negotiate its own agreement terms. Motion made to appoint Sauber Engineering to begin preliminary engineering on BRO-0019(020) PCN 22434 by Reinhardt, seconded by Hochhalter. Roll call vote – Reinhardt – aye, Hochhalter – aye, Zenker – aye. Motion carried.

Motion to pay Larry Nagel for 119 yards of rock at \$10 per yard made by Hochhalter and seconded by Reinhardt. Roll call vote – Reinhardt – aye, Hochhalter – aye, Zenker – aye. Motion carried.

Being no further business, Zenker adjourned meeting at 12:00 p.m.
