

## **Guidelines for Signs on the Common**

**Approved by the Common Commission, April 20, 2023**

### **Signs allowed on the Common**

Official Town Groups – Town administration, boards, commissions, and committees

Non-political voting signs such as ‘Vote’ or signs related to the location of voting, under the direction of the Town Moderator

Old Home Days

Summer Concert Series

Farmer Market

Other signs approved by the Select Board at least one month in advance.

Hancock based Civic Groups – Farmers Market, Historical Society, Women’s Club, Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts and similar organizations.

Signs as approved by the Common Commission at least one month in advance.

Signs for Official Town Groups and Civic Groups shall be sandwich board type with a maximum size of 24” x 48”. No signs shall be staked into the ground or attached to trees, telephone poles or signposts.

Signs shall be allowed 5 days prior to the event and removed by the end of the day after, unless otherwise approved by the Select Board.

Political signs must be handheld.

### **Signs not allowed on the Common**

No private or commercial signs will be allowed (yard sales, business sales, real estate, etc.)

Banners type signs are not allowed.
