

REGULAR MEETING OF HETTINGER COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
November 7, 2019

Regular meeting of November 7, 2019, 8:30 am, all voting in favor and motions carried unless noted otherwise. Members present, John Plaggemeyer, Ron Friedt and Angela Carlson. Elliot Finck, Road Supervisor was also present. Friedt motioned to approve the October minutes as presented, seconded by Carlson.

Carlson moved to approve the bills as presented: General fund 26,745.75; Road & Bridge 27,617.31; E911 7,664.76; County Agent 595.81; Weed Control 350.38; Sheriff's Dept. 13,635.11; 24/7 1,430.65.

Check numbers 11320-11326 in the amount of \$1,457.84 was paid out for Social Services, Friedt seconded the motion to approve bills.

The following reports were reviewed: Recorder Fees-\$1,418.00; Overweight Truck permits-\$2,475.58; Sheriff's fees 1,783.00.

Friedt motioned to accept the building permit application submitted by Jeremy and Holly Ottmar for a house, seconded by Carlson.

Amber Hoheisel, Tax Director, presented the commissioners with an abatement request for two homestead credit abatements. Friedt motioned to accept abatements #425 and #426, seconded by Carlson.

Elliott Finck gave the road supervisor report.

Duaine Marxen, County Agent, came in to present his monthly report. The Christmas Tree Contest will have a first and second place for People's Choice this year.

Heidi Marxen met with the board to go over the County Fair Board budget.

Tracy Kruger, Emergency Manager, met with the board. Friedt motioned to rescind the burn ban, seconded by Carlson. Tracy told the board the Public Assistance Grant is closed out. The county received \$12,790.80 for work that was done on roads in the county. She also updated the commission on SORN 2020.

Judy Kirschmann, JDA Director gave her monthly report.

Billy Doerr, Brosz Engineering, updated the board on the status of the two federal projects that were completed. He thought the completion should be in a couple of weeks. They will start the environmental work next spring on the Bentley Bridge in order to be able to start work on it when the funds become available in 2021.

Sheriff Warner presented her monthly report.

The board discussed longevity for the employees and that it will be paid out this month.
